About the practice questions

This bank of 24 practice questions is designed to help you to prepare for the EnglishScore mobile English Speaking test. The questions are written to the same standard as the questions you will see in the exam.

There are 3 types of question in the Speaking test:

Read Aloud

Listen and Repeat

Answer Questions

There are instructions at the start of each question type. Each question type includes questions for the four **CEFR** levels that EnglishScore covers: **A2, B1, B2, C1**.

The questions cover the Personal, Public and Professional domains, using authentic language and contexts.

The speaking test assesses:

Pronunciation - saying the words in a way that other people can understand

Fluency - speaking at an appropriate speed, without stopping or pausing a lot

Communication - answering the question completely, with examples and/or additional information

Note that EnglishScore is a mobile test, so the question format in the real test is different from what you see in this bank, e.g. in the mobile test, you will need to tap the record button when you speak. However, this question bank will help you to prepare and practise for the test and to understand the different question types we use in our Speaking test.

In the real test you can watch the videos twice. We recommend you also try to listen only twice when using these practice questions. We also recommend you record your answers so you can listen to them and improve as you answer the questions.

Speaking Practice Questions

Read Aloud

A2 Speaking practice questions – Read aloud

Look at a short sentence. Read this out loud, focusing on pronunciation and fluency.

1 Cinema with friends

I usually go to the cinema with friends in my free time.

2 Salad and sandwich

I'd like a sandwich and a salad, please.

B1 Speaking practice questions – Read aloud

1 New manager

Have you heard that there's a new manager in customer services starting tomorrow?

2 New phone

That phone is the first thing I'm going to buy when I get paid.

B2 Speaking practice questions – Read aloud

1 Good teammates

I've been working in this industry for three years, and I feel like I've learnt the most from my teammates.

2 Ask for help

I find that it's far easier to ask your colleagues for help than it is to fix problems later.

C1 Speaking practice questions – Read aloud

1 Team leader

Our new team leader is much more easy-going than the last one and is making some positive changes in the office.

2 Satisfied client

Even though things might not have gone as we expected, it seems that the client was satisfied with what we had to show.

Watch a short video of someone saying a sentence. Listen carefully and then repeat the sentence, focusing on pronunciation and fluency. In the test, you can watch the video twice.

1 Pizza

Listen to the speaker and repeat the sentence.

2 Favourite colour

Listen to the speaker and repeat the sentence.

B1 Speaking practice questions – Listen and repeat

1 Shopping

Listen to the speaker and repeat the sentence.

2 Good concert

Listen to the speaker and repeat the sentence.

B2 Speaking practice questions – Listen and repeat

1 Terrible hotel

Listen to the speaker and repeat the sentence.

2 Helpful manager

Listen to the speaker and repeat the sentence.

C1 Speaking practice questions – Listen and repeat

1 Regular customers

Listen to the speaker and repeat the sentence.

2 Getting everyone together

Listen to the speaker and repeat the sentence.

Speaking practice questions – Answer questions

Watch a short video of someone asking you a question about a topic. In the test, you can watch the video twice. Listen to the question, and use the other information displayed to answer it in full. You should focus on pronunciation, fluency and communication.

You should try to speak for 20-45 seconds, depending on the question level:

A2 - 20 seconds

B1 - 30 seconds

B2 - 40 seconds

C1 - 45 seconds

C1 Speaking practice questions – Answer questions

1 Advice at work

Watch the video and answer the questions.

You must include:

- who you recommend
- why they are the best person

2 Team work

Watch the video and answer the questions.

You must include your ideas on:

- how much colleagues influence us
- whether it's positive or negative
